You will get hands-on experiences with the processes of project management in an NGO that works for the rights and well-being of LGBT+ asylum seekers and LGBT+ refugees. You will develop and strengthen your competences and profile in project management and gain practical insight into the fields of asylum and integration in Denmark. You will work together with a strong group of dedicated and hardworking volunteers and be closely connected to the Head of Secretariat.

It's mandatory that you can work independently and structured with a great overview over different tasks and deadlines – and that you have excellent writing skills.

The specific projects and tasks for the internship will be presented in the beginning of the internship and can be developed throughout the internship.

LGBT Asylum has its headquarters in Copenhagen and a local group in Aarhus.

LGBT Asylum was started in 2012 by LGBT+ persons who lived as asylum seekers or refugees in Denmark. We deeply value our heritage, and work for our members to have ownership of the organization and be part of as many decisions and processes possible.
