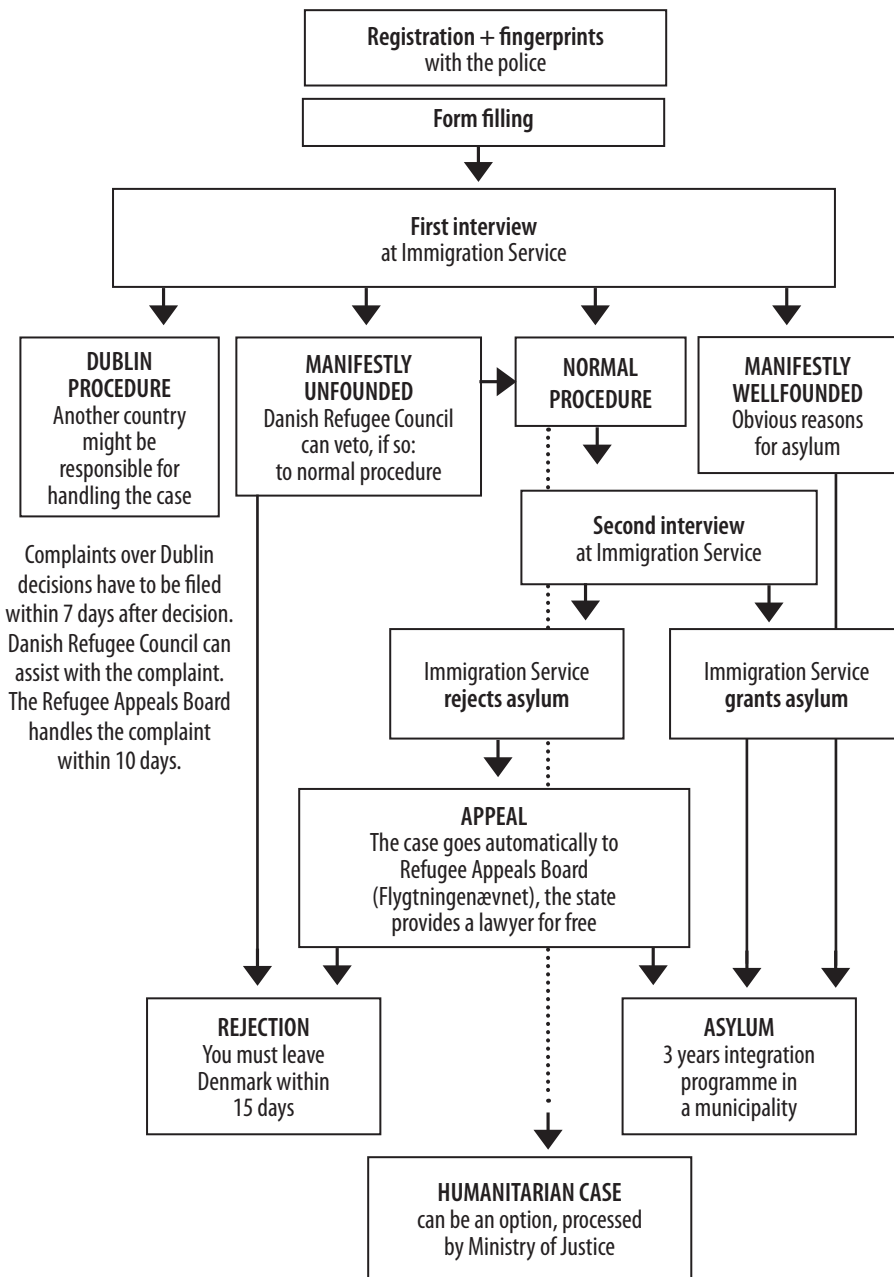


THE ASYLUM PROCEDURE IN DENMARK



Complaints over Dublin decisions have to be filed within 7 days after decision. Danish Refugee Council can assist with the complaint. The Refugee Appeals Board handles the complaint within 10 days.

PHASE 1:
No pocket money
No internship (praktik)
Reception Center Sandholm
(approx 10 days)

PHASE 2:
Move to residence camp
Pocket money
Internship (praktik) + language training
(average 9.5 months in total)

After 6 months (if you sign the voluntary return contract):
Right to work/study
Access to live outside camp

PHASE 3 (if you are rejected and do not cooperate):
Move to deportation camp Sjælsmark
No pocket money
No internship (praktik), study or work
Risk of closed camp
Weekly meetings with police

12 months after final rejection (cooperating or not):
Families with children get access to live outside the camps, but not to work/study
